

Retouch Image Using Content Aware Tool

(ie, power lines, light posts, garbage cans)

FYI:

- Spot healing brush, fill and patch tools > defaults are set to content aware
- Results are 80-90 % perfect, may need to touch up with clone stamp tool

FILL:

Choose lasso > Make sure first icon in settings is selected > Select unwanted item > Edit > fill > content aware > (be sure to also select shadows that may be attached to your unwanted objects!)

PATCH:

With a larger area like a brick wall, use the patch tool.

Select with lasso > choose patch > be sure content aware is on > drag the selection (by clicking inside of it and dragging) to an area you believe would work well as a "patch" > Hold mouse down until you are happy or else it will accept the patch.

CONTENT AWARE MOVE TOOL:

found under the patch tool > select image and any reflections > click inside image, drag to the area you want to move it to > keep all horizontal elements aligned before you let go of the mouse. Photoshop will not fix horizontal alignments for you. (good for brick walls or anything that will be too tedious to work with)
